



Graduate Scholarship Information

Academic Year 2018-2019

This scholarship is offered by the Oregon Section of the Institute of Transportation Engineers to promote the advancement of the transportation profession by providing financial assistance to students pursuing degrees in transportation engineering or other related fields.

Scholarship Award

The Oregon Section of ITE will award two scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each. One will be awarded to an undergraduate student and one will be awarded to a graduate student.

Eligibility Requirements

Students must fulfill the following requirements:

- *Graduate Scholarship*: Full-time or part-time graduate student enrolled at an ABET accredited college or university in the State of Oregon
- Candidate must be pursuing a degree in civil engineering, transportation engineering, transportation planning or other transportation related field that supports the goals of ITE
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher

Selection Criteria

Candidates will be evaluated based on academic performance, educational plans, career goals, extracurricular activities, work experience and record of leadership. Evaluations will be made based on a completed application and a recommendation form provided by a faculty member, faculty advisor or employer. Special consideration will be given to student members of the Oregon Section of ITE. Candidates will be evaluated based on the following four criteria:

1. Academic Performance (0-20 points)
2. Work Experience/Volunteer Work (0-30 points)
3. Career Goals and Objectives (*personal statement*) (0-40 points)
4. ITE Involvement (0-10 points)

Application Instructions

To apply for the Oregon ITE Scholarship, the student candidate must complete and return the attached **Scholarship Application Form** and **University Transcript** no later than **May 3, 2019**.

Recommendation Forms can be included with the application and transcript submittal or mailed/emailed separately, but must be received no later than **May 3, 2019**.
